Guidance and Discipline Procedures

Techniques for handling various discipline situations

- Redirect the child to an alternative.
- Make changes to the learning environment by redesigning it or impoverishing it.
- Help the child see alternatives and make decisions.
- Model and encourage appropriate behavior.
- Create logical, natural consequences.

Discipline techniques forbidden by the Center

- No child shall be subjected to cruel treatment, humiliation or verbal abuse.
- Corporal punishment, including spankings, is strictly forbidden.
- No child shall be threatened, made to sleep, or denied food.
- No child shall be punished for soiling or wetting clothing or diapers.

Climbing Wall Permission

- My child has permission to participate in the climbing wall unit at The Children's Center. I understand that this activity involves some risk of injury and I will stress the importance of the class safety rules with my child at home. (over age 3 only)

Your Child has the opportunity to participate in a climbing wall unit as a part of our physical education program. We are using a traverse climbing wall to host many exciting activities. At its highest point, the wall measures eight (8) feet and is approximately 12 feet long. Participants climb horizontally (traverse) across the wall and their feet should never be higher than three and a half (3 1/2) feet above the floor. Your child will be informed of safety rules and will climb under the careful supervision of an adult instructor at all times.

Indoor rock climbing is one of the fastest growing activities today. It simultaneously develops coordination, strength, flexibility and cardiovascular fitness. Additionally, important life skills like problem-solving, goal setting, perseverance, inner confidence and patience will be learned in this unit.

In order for your child to participate in our climbing wall unit, a signed permission slip must be completed and on file. Should you have any questions about this opportunity, please ask your child's teacher or the Education Manager.
